The football first team defense included three players from both Pleasant Ridge and Wathena. The Rams' Brian Heintzleman was a tackle, with Matt Meinert at linebacker and cornerback Derek Warden. The Wildcats had Colby Rohde at end, Corbin Schultz at linebacker and Brett Barger at tackle. Horton's defensive duo of Casey Tulk at nose guard and Jamika Teel at linebacker were named first team, with Valley Falls' Cameron Bickford at end, Mark Stewart of McLouth at safety and Caylor Luther of Troy at cornerback to round out the list.

Offensively, Troy had three first-team selections, including Luther at running back, center Jesse Marriott, and Colin Greaser at quarterback.
